## 2016 Connecticut State Scholastic Quick Chess Championships

On May 14, 2016, 35 players from 14 towns and 24 schools competed in the 2016 Inaugural Connecticut State Scholastic Quick Chess Championships held at the Farmington Main Library, Farmington, Connecticut. Competition was directed by IM Jan van de Mortel.

The tournament, the first of its kind, was organized as a non-profit fundraiser for scholastic chess programs by the Connecticut Chess Organization and co-sponsored by the Farmington Libraries, allClubs Chess, and the University of Connecticut Chess Club.
