McHugh played against 23 central Connecticut area chess players. He deafeated 18 of the players, lost two games and drew with three other players. Robert Kozlowski of New Britain, a graduate student at CCSU, was the first player to defeat the master and was awarded a chess book donated by the NBCC. Joseph Hladun of Wethersfield was the other winner. Jason Lenore, 14, of West Hartford, and John Baclawski and Arkadijź Strazdins of New Britain drew with McHugh.

The next simultaneous exhibitions at the NBCC will be performed by national senior chess masters Nelson Castaneda of New Britain on Aug. 28 and Richard Bauer of Wolcott on Sept. 18.

Arkadijs Strazdins' name appears in the U.S. Chess Federation Rating List for April 2001 in a listing "The Nation's Top Players." Strazdins, 78, is ranked 41st in the category of Top U.S. 50 over 65.
